
To the Corona del Sol High School Community:

The intent of this letter and future communications is to ensure you have accurate information regarding District actions concerning Corona del Sol's air quality.

1. A community forum was held last week making the latest air quality information available to parents, staff and students and providing the Corona community an opportunity to ask questions and make comments.
2. Communications to the community have been posted on the District website ([www.tuhsd.k12.az.us](http://www.tuhsd.k12.az.us)) and will be updated periodically as additional information becomes available.
3. In an effort to bring additional fresh air into the building as soon as possible, District staff is working with the Design Team to evaluate necessary construction phases. Details of that plan will be made available as soon as complete.
4. Diane Meulemans, Chief Financial Officer, and I are collaborating with Health Effects Group to identify if any additional tests should be conducted.
5. Ms. Meulemans and I requested the AZ Department of Health Services conduct a **confidential** survey of students and current and former staff members with health concerns who believe they have been affected by the quality of Corona's air. Survey forms may be picked up in the Principal's office beginning Monday, March 17. Completed surveys must be returned to the Principal's office in a sealed envelope no later than **Thursday, March 27**. (Envelopes will remain sealed until reviewed by AZ Department of Health Services personnel.) The survey will be administered and analyzed independently and is entirely voluntary.
6. We are working with Health Effects Group and an ASU professor (and Corona parent) to conduct a health questionnaire to evaluate the incidents of health complaints at the school.

The District is pursuing all viable options to expedite resolution of air quality issues and to address concerns identified by the community.
