

Dear Parent/Guardian:

It is flu season, and the H1N1 Flu (Swine Flu) is still at pandemic levels in Arizona. Tempe Union High School District supports the efforts of the Maricopa County Public Health Department to prevent the spread of this flu, and has provided an opportunity for your student(s) to receive the H1N1 vaccinations.

H1N1 Flu (Swine Flu) vaccinations will be administered by Mollen Immunization Clinics for Tempe Union High School District students and employees ONLY on December 7 and 9 at our District Office. The District Office address is 500 W. Guadalupe Rd., in Tempe. The clinics will run 3:00pm to 6:00pm. Students and staff must have school photo identification badges and \$15 (exact change or check) to cover administrative costs. However, students will not be turned away if they are uninsured or unable to pay. **Parents, siblings or other family members will not be eligible to receive the vaccination at these clinics.**

Mollen will only provide vaccinations to students and staff on their school's scheduled date.
