What Is Grad Night?

An ongoing tradition at Marcos, grad night is an all-night party (from approximately 11 p.m. to 5:30 a.m.) held at ASU's Memorial Union, and includes food, entertainment, games, great prizes and more. For many of them, it will be the last time they will be together as a class, and this is a wonderful and safe way for our kids to celebrate their achievement. We want to have 75% attendance by our grads—that's more than 300 students!

What is Involved?

- ◆ \$20,000!!! It is expensive-but all the funds go toward the seniors-rental of the facility, entertainment, food, and lots of prizes.
- ◆ Attend Grad Night Organizational Meetings (see below for schedule)
- ◆ Fundraising and Volunteering make this a great event
 - Sell Poinsettias for the holidays-we earn 50% of the sales (see flier)
 - Tax Credit donations—single filing is up to \$200; married couples up to \$300 (in 2006 it will be \$400) (see flier)
 - Volunteer at the Tempe Arts Festival in December and March (we receive funds)
 - Solicit door prizes or gift cards from local businesses (these will go directly to students)
 - Padre Golf Tournament in April-golf, volunteer, or help solicit prizes
 - Buy a Senior Brick for your grad (see flier)
 - Solicit corporate sponsors to help with the event
 - Be a chaperone at Grad Night-we will need people for registration, as casino dealers, in the prize room, etc.
