

**MPHS ARIZONA UNIVERSITY REFERENCE GUIDE  
ASU, NAU & U of A ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS**

- Required 16 high school core courses** – completed with cumulative 2.0 grade point average in each subject area
- 4 years of English (no Communication level classes)
  - 4 years of Math (Algebra 1-2, Geometry, Algebra 3-4 & Pre-Calculus, Honors Trig, or Calculus)
  - 3 years of Lab Science (Chem/Physics, Biology 1-2, Chemistry, Biotech, Anatomy/Physiology, Earth Science or Physics)
  - 2 years of Social Studies (American History and one other)
  - 2 years of Foreign Language (must be 2 years of the same language)
  - 1 year of Fine Art (designated Music, Art or Drama classes)

**ASU Main, ASU Downtown Phoenix Capitol Center, ASU West, ASU Polytechnic, or NAU Aptitude Requirement Student** must meet one of the following aptitude criteria:

- Top 25% of graduation class (top 26-50% considered)
- 3.0 GPA in 16 competency courses (2.5-2.99 considered)
- 1040 SAT Reasoning
- 22 ACT

**Upon receipt of “letter of acknowledgement”, student should set up “My ASU Interactive Account”. Directions for setup are in the letter of acknowledgement and all communication will be done through this account.**

**U of A Assured Admission—**

- Top 25% of graduation class
- 3.0 GPA in each core area and completion of ALL 16 core requirements
- SAT Reasoning or ACT score must be on file to be considered for merit scholarships. Must be an Arizona resident to receive in-state tuition. Selective (Delegated) Admission with comprehensive review.

**TRANSCRIPT REQUEST PROCEDURE FOR COLLEGES/SCHOLARSHIPS**

**Transcript request forms are available in the Guidance Office. Official transcripts must be sent directly from MPHS to the college you are applying to.** Carefully follow the procedure outlined (**including placing the appropriate postage on the envelope**) before returning your request form to the request inbox. It is highly recommended that any paper application be submitted with your transcript request. They will be mailed together which will expedite the application process. If you apply online, simply fill out the transcript request as indicated on the form. Allow one week for processing of transcript request.

**ACT/SAT - MPHS CODE: 030307**

**ACT/SAT Scores are NOT included on a student’s transcript and must be sent directly from the testing company to the University/Scholarship opportunity. This can be done online or at the time of test registration.**

Most colleges and universities will accept either the **ACT or the SAT Reasoning** scores for college admissions. Some colleges (for example UCLA) require the SAT Subject Tests as well as the SAT Reasoning or ACT scores. The SAT Reasoning and SAT Subject Tests cannot be taken on the same Saturday. Students should consult college websites for specific test requirements. SAT and ACT info and practice tests are available in Guidance. You may also apply online at [www.collegeboard.com](http://www.collegeboard.com) (SAT) or [www.actstudent.org](http://www.actstudent.org) (ACT). Register early to secure your preferred test site and test date.
