

Physical Packet Checklist to use for tryouts for 2011-12 Pride Sports:

- Please bring **ORIGINAL** state certified birth certificate or passport document(s) to the Pride Athletics Office. Certified copies are made in the Athletics Office and kept on file for the years the student athlete is here at MP.
- Please bring to the Athletics Office the pink receipt from paying the **\$50 activity fee in the Bookstore**. The \$50 activity fee per sport [cash or check] can be paid at the Pride Bookstore, open during regular school hours and closed daily for one hour. This \$50 activity fee qualifies for tax credit; if you pay in the Bookstore, you will receive a receipt; if you complete an on-line tax credit donation, please specify your student athlete's sport(s) and submit a copy with the completed physical packet and keep a copy of the receipt(s) for your records. *Please remember to make payment of activity fee within same fiscal year that your student athlete participates in sports.*
- Student athlete must get a complete physical after March 1, 2011 in the AIA/TUHSD physical packet. This physical must be done in this provided physical packet, dated, signed and with the printed name/address/phone of the physician. These are always available in the Athletics Office on the wall. This physical [packet] will be sufficient for the entire school year. An equipment card is issued for each sport. **Photo or faxed copies of a physical are unacceptable.**
- Complete** both sides of the provided **two (2)** Emergency Cards. **Both** of these cards must be completed. One yellow card is for the Coach; the other yellow card is for the Trainer.
- Complete** the AIA (Arizona Interscholastic Association) Mild Traumatic Brain Injury (MTBI)/Concussion form.
- Complete** all four (4) sides of physical packet with parent and student signatures on the left inside and backside. **Every athlete must have insurance**, either provided by their parent(s)/guardian(s) or through Myers-Stevens, who provide Student Accident & Health insurance. If this insurance is needed, you can contact them directly at #1-800-827-4695 and/or the Myers-Stevens application is available in the Athletics Office for you to turn it in with payment *for the Pride Athletics Office to mail.*
- Please review the enclosed Pride Board Membership Form.

During Book Distribution, please inform cashier of the sport(s) in which your student athlete will participate. Pride Book Distribution starts Tuesday, July 26 through Wednesday, August 3, 7:30am – 12pm. ***The Bookstore will be closed Thurs. 8/4 & Fri. 8/5, so be sure to pay all FALL sport activity fees during Book Distribution.***

Tryouts for Fall Sports begin Monday, August 8, 2011, the 1st day of school; Winter Sport tryouts will be October 31; for Spring Sports, Boys & Girls Tennis tryouts are January 23, 2012; Baseball/Softball/Track/Volleyball tryouts are February 6, 2012. *No equipment cards are issued on 1st day of tryouts.*

If the student is not living with a natural parent, legal court appointed guardianship papers must be on file. If a student is not living in the school attendance boundary, but is living with his/her natural parents, open enrollment papers must be on file.

Regarding academic eligibility, the student must be enrolled in and passing 5-credit earning classes. An audit class does not count as a credit class. Seniors who are on track to graduate may be enrolled in 4-credit earning classes to be eligible. Grades of "F", incomplete or audit are considered non-passing grades and will render a student ineligible to participate.

REFUNDS: The student athlete not selected for a team must come to the Athletics Office to pick up a ***refund form*** to take to the Bookstore. If payment was made with a check, the check must clear from the bank before a refund can be issued, usually a 30 day period.

Once this checklist is complete, please bring entire packet to the Pride Athletics Office at least one day before tryouts. An equipment card will then be issued for the desired sport.

NOTE: no equipment cards will be issued on the 1st day of tryouts.
